



Chris Holmes Memorial Scholarship

The Chris Holmes Memorial Scholarship will provide \$3000 in funding towards a seaplane rating with Fort Langley Air LTD. Applicants must be a Canadian resident, holding a Private Pilot License or greater, with a minimum 150 hours total time. Scholarship winners must complete their seaplane rating within 12 months of the date of award.

The successful candidate will be selected based on merit, aviation career aspirations, dedication to their goals as well as community contribution.

Requirements & Process

Application Package - Please submit one complete set of the following components together as ONE package via email to info@fortlangleyair.com with .pdf attachments, subject line: Chris Holmes Memorial Scholarship.

- Two (2) one-page recommendation letters from past instructors or fellow pilots familiar with your flying experience, at least one must be from a pilot that has flown with you
- Copies of all aviation and medical certificates and the last three pages of your pilot logbook
- A short essay highlighting your career or float flying aspirations (max 500 words)
- Your resume detailing relevant experience.

*Note: Please ensure your cover letter and resume have your name, address, telephone and e-mail information.

Your application package should answer these questions:

- Why you want to fly floats
- Your aviation history and goals, including where you see yourself in five and ten years
- Demonstrated involvement in aviation activities
- Educational scholarships, awards and honors
- How the scholarship will help you achieve your objective and your present financial need
- Your plans and commitment to complete your float rating within the required time period.

Awards

The successful candidate will be notified April 15, annually.
